^{*} Footnote #4 permits the monitoring of medications by a credentialed, expanded scope paramedic <u>outside of the presence</u> of a PHRN or higher when functioning on a licensed critical care ground ambulance.

| Remove: | "Chest tube thorocostomy, monitoring after acute Insertion" | This is a redundant statement and is covered in the line above which states, "Chest tube thorocostomy, monitoring of existing tube in a closed system, e.g. water seal or suction" | |

| Add: | "Ventilators, transport – used in multimodal settings, blended gas transport ventilator on patients ventilated <48 hours or anticipated need to actively titrate ventilator settings" | Add Footnote # 2** This statement appears in the air ambulance scope of practice document, however it appears to have been unintentionally omitted from the ground CCT transport scope of practice. | |

^{**} Footnote #2 permits the monitoring/initiation of a therapy by a credentialed, expanded scope paramedic <u>in the presence</u> of a PHRN or higher when functioning on a licensed critical care ground ambulance.
